Operate various jobsite equipment including forklifts, boom lifts, and scissor lifts, in accordance with OSHA and site safety protocols. Assist skilled tradespeople as needed with framing, demolition, and finish work. Maintain a clean and organized jobsite through regular housekeeping duties and debris removal. Perform inventory checks and material handling to support job progress and prevent delays. Serve as a flagger to direct traffic and maintain safety during deliveries or crane operations. Measure and complete layout of commercial buildings. Install shoring, safety rails, and unload material trucks. With generators to provide power for tools, machinery, or equipment. Position and dismantle prefab walls, using saws, hammers, nails, or bolts. Position, join, align, or seal structural components. Operate boom, scissor or forklifts. Site housekeeping, inventory control and flagger.

Salary/Wages/Benefits

\$18.61 an hour weekly, or approximately 60 hours per week, up to 10 overtime hours may be offered, however are not guaranteed. From Monday through Saturday 10 hour days. Applicants may be offered more than advertised. The wage rate may vary based on experience and/or merit. \$27.92/hr for overtime. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, the employer will provide or pay for the worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer or where the employer has appropriately reported a worker's voluntary abandonment of employment. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. In the first workweek, daily subsistence for travel to the place of employment will be reimbursed at a rate of at least \$16.28/day to a maximum of \$68.00/day with receipts. Also, workers will be reimbursed in the first workweek for all visas, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government (except passport fees). The employer will provide workers without charge or deposit charge for all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.
